## **Student to Supply:**

As Maiwa has a well stocked studio there are things on the list of supplies that you should definitely bring and those that you will find in our studio but may want to have your own familiar tools or materials.

## Supplies That You Should Definitely Bring Are As Follows:

Two pads of Bristol paper 8" X 10"

- 2 Tubes Acryla Gouache: 20 ml tubes, 1 one each of Primary Black and Titanium White (can be purchased at Opus)
- 1 Pilot .05 felt pen
- 2 sheets 'Stonehenge' paper 22 X 30, 250 gsm
- 10 sheets of black construction paper about 8 X 10 inches (please do not buy expensive paper, Opus Art Supply on Granville Island sells a pad of black construction paper)
- 6B pencil
- 2 good water-colour brushes; one round, size 10 or 12, one flat about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an inch wide, these should be medium size ie. comfortable to use on an 8 X 10 piece of paper
- 8.5 X 11 or 11 X 14 inch Manila folders X 3 (or more) for each day's exercises (work needs organizing after each session as there are lots of exercises)

## Supplies That You Would Find In Our Studio But Might Want To Bring From Home Are:

- Sharp Scissors for creative paper cutting
- Sharp, new X-acto blade
- Ruler metal 18 inch
- Glue stick (archival)

- As some students prefer to work with their own favorite tools and supplies feel free to bring them to augment the studio supplies - this could include drawing pencils, scissors, etc. These items are optional.

- Note: If you have taken one of Eleanor's Design workshops before please bring your samples from those workshops for the co-creation of a "design sample book".

All personal tools should be labeled to ensure they don't go astray.
